A. Overview of the County-Wide Homelessness Strategic Plan

Ernest Stephens of Morant McLeod presented the strategic plan for Homelessness in Lincoln County. Council and Staff had a discussion regarding housing supply and numbers.

B. LCP&R New Park Budget

Jeanne Sprague, Parks and Recreation Director, gave a presentation regarding the new park and budgeting for the new year. Debbie Bridges, Finance Director, spoke regarding the TRT increase. Ms. Bridges said the increase went to the Police Department. Council and Staff asked about other ideas for raising funds for the park. Ms. Bridges will look into the idea of "rounding up for City services". Ms. Sprague explained the aspects they have been working with the Confederated Tribes of the Siletz Indians. Council and Staff also discussed seating options at the new Taft Park.

C. Outside Agencies Grant Application Review

Council President Casper spoke regarding the Outside Agency Requests received. The Council and Staff discussed the various options for distribution. The Council decided to table the discussion for another meeting.

D. Miscellaneous

Council President Casper spoke about Human Trafficking and getting information to the community. Councilor Parsons said that he would like a workshop with the Council to give information regarding human trafficking.
