The Executive Session meeting is called to order under the authority of Oregon Revised Statutes:

- ORS 192.660(2)(a) (To consider the employment of a public officer, employee, staff member, or individual agent).
- ORS 192.660(2)(f) (To consider information or records that are exempt by law from public inspection).
- ORS 192.660(2)(h) (To consult with counsel concerning the legal rights and duties of a public body with regard to current litigation or litigation likely to be filed).

3. City Attorney project list- internal advisory communication

Executive Sessions are open to the media with the exception of 192.660(2) (d) (labor negotiations) at which the news media's attendance is at the discretion of the Council. (Note: Council has previously made the decision to exclude media from such meetings by Resolution / Order.)

News Media Representatives are specifically directed not to report on any deliberations during the executive session, except to state the general subject of the session as

previously announced. In executive session meetings, cameras, tape recorders, and other recording devices shall not be used; except for the official executive session recording. No decision may be made in executive session
