RESOLUTION NO. 2022-37 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN CITY SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS THE QUESTION OF AMENDING THE LINCOLN CITY CHARTER TO INCREASE THE TRANSIENT ROOM TAX FROM NINE AND ONE-HALF PERCENT (9.5%) TO TWELVE PERCENT (12%) FOR PUBLIC SAFETY, GENERAL GOVERNMENT AND TOURISM-RELATED FACILITIES.
