- **ORS 192.660(2)(f) (To consider information or records that are exempt by law from public inspection).**
- **ORS 192.660(2)(h) (To consult with counsel concerning the legal rights and duties of a public body with regard to current litigation or litigation likely to be filed).**

- **Status of Note(s) / Trust Deed(s) / Construction Loans for 2020 real property conveyances – internal advisory communication**

No decision may be made in executive session.
