Infrastructure-Long-Range Planning:

Maintain, restore, and create ongoing projects for City's long-range planning responsibility. Also, discuss lighting code.

Parks and Recreation:

Provide and maintain natural resources and recreational opportunities. Also stabilize funding.

Sustainability:

Provide direction for a healthy community that is sustainable and environmentally friendly. Also, the Climate action plan.

Financial:

Discuss PERS with the Budget Committee.
