## FISCAL YEAR 2020 CITY COUNCIL GOALS AND PRIORITIES

Social Welfare Services - Social Welfare services provide assistance to individuals and families that are in need. Councilor Hinton has suggested that we change the title of this to "Community Support."

### Tasks

- Assess the City's needs for social welfare services.
- Partner with nonprofit organizations that provide social welfare services.
  - Consider opportunities to provide social welfare service facilities for nonprofit organizations.
- Be more active encouraging the County to extend social welfare services in Lincoln City.

### Code Enforcement

#### Tasks

- Approach – proactive
- Prioritize nuisances to enforce, (i.e. abandoned vehicles, leash laws)
- Develop an education component as part of enforcement, i.e. pedestrian safety program.
- Provide sufficient funding in the budget for code enforcement fund and develop policies for exercising summary abatement.
- Create a coordinated, team approach to enforcement.

### Parks and Recreation

- Develop the Taft park
- Develop the Keel Park
- Develop a dog park

### Expand Economic Opportunities: Business Expansion and Workforce Housing

#### **Business – Tasks**

- Broadband Development – Identify the underserved; expand broadband opportunities for the underserved.
- Identify properties that can be purchased and redeveloped.
- Expand the tool box
- Amend the City zoning ordinance to permit food carts, trucks, trailers, etc.

#### **Workforce Housing – Tasks**

- Develop the Villages with a workforce housing component.
- Expand tool box
- Transitional housing

### Infrastructure – Long Range Planning

#### Tasks

- Expand water capacity by working on a regional approach.
- Hold the line on capital improvement plans and financing projects.

### Emergency Preparation

#### Tasks

- Continue the cache program
- Community education program
- Consider assistance for household emergency preparedness
